

Personal, Social, and Emotional Development (PSED):

- We will talk about how we can care for animals like Princess Pearl did in Zog.
- We will become confident in taking part in new social situations by taking part in sports day.
- We will adapt our behaviour to different events and changes in routine by spending time in reception class getting to know our new teachers and setting.

Literacy (L):

- We will begin to blend and segment CVC words.
- We will learn that print carries meaning and is read from left to right, top to bottom.
- We will share Julia Donaldson stories talking about the story setting, events, and main characters.
- We will give meaning to the letters we write and ascribe meaning to the marks we see.

Maths (M):

- We will begin to use mathematical names for 2D and 3D shapes.
- We will show an interest in number problems.
- We will recognise numerals 1-5 then 1-10 and beyond.
- We will learn to match numeral and quantity correctly.

Expressive Arts and Design (EAD):

- We will use movement in response to music to express feelings by a variety of styles of music e.g. classical/pop/jazz.
- We will capture experiences and responses with a range of media.
- We will begin to create simple representations of events, people and objects.

Understanding of the World (UW):

- We will discuss where different insects might live and how they move around in their habitats.
- We will make and talk about a mini beast motel and the type of life inside them.
- We will learn that some things make us unique and talk about our similarities and difference like Zog did with his friends.

Communication and Language (CAL):

- We will continue to question why things happen and how things work by finding out how worms dig their holes like Superworm.
- We will build up a vocabulary that reflects our experiences by discussing what we could see, hear, smell and feel on our different adventures.
- We will use talk to connect ideas explain what is happening and anticipate what might happen next by making potions like the Witch in Room on the Broom.

Physical Development (PD):

- We will learn how to catch a large ball.
- We will learn to run skilfully negotiating spaces, adjusting speed and direction, avoiding obstacles.
- We will learn to hold a pencil near point between first two fingers and thumb and use it with good control.
- We will learn how to draw a variety of lines (squiggle lines).
- We will learn to copy some letters.
- We will learn to observe what happens to our body after we exercise.
- We will begin to talk about staying healthy.
