

## Art/D&T

- The children will develop artistic skills such as pleating, cutting, folding, tearing and sticking by painting and creating collages using a range of materials.
- The children will explore objects and designs and state what they like about them.
- The children will design their own products.
- The children will use the cookery room to make meals safely and hygienically.

## History/Geography

- The children will compare their lives to the past as part of our Victorian Day.
- We will discuss language such as: 'old', 'new', 'a long time ago', 'past' and 'present'.
- The children will learn to put up to 3 things in chronological (time) order.
- The children will learn about a range of objects, look at the differences between old and new.
- The children will use artefacts and pictures to explore what the past was like.
- The children will learn about Remembrance Day.
- The children will learn about the British Isles and their capital cities. They will do this using maps.
- The children will learn about physical and human features.

## PSHRE

- We will work on playing and working co-operatively.
- The children will help to create classroom rules.
- We will look at how humans grow from young to old.
- The children will explore different ways of staying clean and naming parts of the body.

## PE

- The children will develop basic skills such as running, hopping, jumping, catching, throwing, skipping and galloping.
- We will learn to travel safely and use space in different ways.
- We will move at different speeds.
- They will apply their basic movements to a number of games.
- They will comment on their own performance.

## Science

- The children will learn about animals and humans.
- They will learn how to classify animals, including humans into the 5 main groups.
- The children will learn about herbivores, omnivores and carnivores.

## Music

- The children will listen carefully to music, beginning to recognise simple styles and different sounds.
- The children will find the pulse of the music by clapping.
- The children will share their own opinions about a piece of music.
- The children will take part in warm ups and sing songs.

## ICT

- The children will learn to be creators by mastering basic skills such as logging on, finding a programme, creating digital content and storing it safely.
- The children will learn how to use a digital camera to take photos and how to upload these to the computer.
- They will learn about E-Safety focussing on the importance of a password and keeping it safe.
- They children will learn about the SMART rules. These will show them why we need to be safe and how to be safe on the internet.

## English

- The children will learn how to write labels, lists and captions based on a story.
- The children will learn how to sequence and write stories using a beginning, middle and end.
- The children will write a set of instructions based on an experience within the class.
- We will use adjectives to create character and setting descriptions.
- The children will write a letter.

## RE

- We will be focussing on how different people show that they care for one another.
- The children will learn about belonging.

## Maths

- The children will learn about Place Value up to the number 20.
- The children will learn how to add and subtract with numbers up to 10.
- We will learn about 2D and 3D shapes.
