

Art/D&T

We will collect our own natural tools to recreate cave paintings by focussing on size and thickness of each stroke.

We will explore different painting techniques to recreate the Stone Age hand paintings.

We will design, make and evaluate Stone Age jewellery.

Science

We will learn about the different rocks and soils.

We will investigate diets of humans and animals.

We will learn that some animals have skeletons and muscles.

Music

We will look at a famous rock song and identify the instruments used in the piece.

We will compare the genre to other music genres.

We will then practice the Stone Age version of this piece and perform it to an audience.

History/Geography

We will find out about the three periods of the Stone Age and understand why each one is important.

We will begin to imagine what life was like for the early settlers and recognise how the Stone Age has helped to shape our lives.

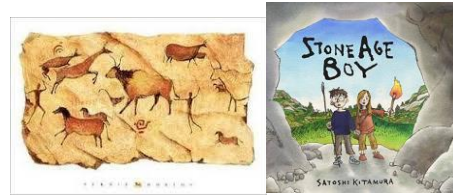
We will begin to use a compass to build our knowledge of the UK.
